Passage of the Engineer Intern Examination or similar, would be a plus.

- 2. Convening, at least monthly, meetings with the Contractor(s) and Engineering Consultant(s), for the purpose of coordinating works activities.
- Assist Project Coordinator (PC) in the invitation and evaluation of bids including the preparation of bid reports and recommend the award of supply and construction contracts.
- 4. Assist PC in management and administration of the procurement process.
- 5. Provide cost control.
- 6. Expedite the submissions of claims for disbursement to CDB through PC.
- 7. Keep accounts on relevant project-related expenditures and disbursement activities.
- 8. Prepare, and submit to PC, fortnightly reports on progress of the works.
- Participate and report on formal community participation in implementation of the Project, including discussions of a certificate of practical completion of each works contract.
- 10. Perform any other related duty as assigned.
