INTERRUPTION IN WATER SUPPLY – CUSTOMERS IN WSC DANNOTTAGE SUPPLY DISTRICT, WEDNESDAY - JULY 3RD, 2013 AND THURSDAY - JULY 4TH, 2013 AND WINTON PUMPING STATION SUPPLY AREA JULY 4TH, 2013

DANNOTTAGE SUPPLY DISTRICT

The Corporation apologizes to our valued customers and the general public, in our Dannottage District, inclusive of side corners off Soldier Road North, Village Road, Bernard Road, the Northern Side of Prince Charles Drive from Marathon Road to Fox Hill Road and surrounding areas, following unexpected challenges experienced over the past two (2) days as highlighted below: -

1. On **Wednesday Jul-03-2013**, we experienced an interruption of normal water supply between the hours of approximately 5AM and 10AM due to a **system failure**.
2. Today, **Thursday Jul-04-2013**, around 8a.m. a **major leak** occurred on the water main serving this District, just north of the Soldier Road/Prince Charles intersection. The repairs were completed around 2pm and normal water supply has been restored.

WINTON PUMPING STATION SUPPLY AREA

The Corporation apologizes to our valued customers and the general public, in our Winton Pumping Station Supply Area who were impacted today, **Thursday Jul-04-2013** around 7AM due to a **pump trip failure at our Winton Pumping Station**. A WSC team was promptly dispatched and after some investigations determined the cause and restored normal water supply around 10AM.

WSC extends sincere apologies to all who were negatively affected by these three (3) events. The Corporation also is requesting the assistance of our valued customers and the general public to:

1. Exercise water conservation measures to the extent practical during these hot summer months,
2. Report signs of leaks and/or wastage to our Call Center at 302-5599 or 325-0505.
